AMF-Bruns Launches Award for Special-Needs School Bus Drivers

Securement supplier **AMF-Bruns of America** is kicking off a new program to recognize school bus drivers who transport students with special needs.

For its first annual National Special-Needs School Bus Driver of the Year Award, AMF-Bruns said it will look for a driver distinguished by “special accomplishments, meritorious and heroic acts, and innovations to improve their jobs.”

The winner of the award will receive a \$1,000 check from AMF-Bruns, which provides [wheelchair and occupant securement equipment](#) for school buses and other vehicles.
