WHAT'S GOING ON IN THE BUS INDUSTRY

New wheelchair system offered for buses

HUDSON, Ohio — The growth of wheelchair passenger travel on buses has led to the development of a new securement system that accommodates wheelchairs while freeing up floor space for non-wheelchair passengers.

The new Smartfloor Hide-A-Way system by AMF Brun is the industry's only wheelchair secure-

ment system in which the retractors are fully integrated into the floor, freeing up valuable floor space and increasing passenger capacity.

Passenger seats, which fold up, can be installed directly over the concealed retractor system. The product, which was test-marketed in Europe, meets ISO 10542

safety requirements.

AMF Brun, founded in Germany in 1962, entered the U.S. market in 2013 when it opened a distribution facility in Ohio.

In the 1970s, the company developed the first wheelchair safety system and invented a four-point retractor wheelchair anchoring system.
